This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. § 552) appeals (DOC-OS-2016-000580 and 581) dated February 8, 2016 seeking a response to your FOIA request (DOC-ITA-2016-000295) submitted to the International Trade Administration (ITA). Your FOIA request sought "all completed copies of the 'National Travel and Tourism Office (NTTO) - Order Form' received by the Office of Travel & Tourism Industries for the 'Air Arrivals I-94 Database Annual Datafile' and/or the 'U.S. International Air Travel Statistics Report (APIS/I-92) Data files.'"

A search for the requested documents revealed no responsive records. Copies of the specific order form you requested were not historically used for orders of the I-94 or I-92 data files.
